Preparations for Downtown Dining Week, March 30th to April 10th:

City of Edmonton Spring Sweep Starts April 11

Beginning April 11, weather permitting, the City of Edmonton will start its spring sweep campaign. The annual street cleaning service will clear debris and dust from roads, bike lanes and major pathways, making them cleaner and safer for all modes of transportation.

Residents and businesses can help do their part by moving their vehicles and providing our crews plenty of room to work as we clear sand and debris from our city's boulevards and streets. **Businesses can help by sweeping debris from their sidewalks and walkways into the road between April 1-10, so city crews can clear away the debris during the spring sweep.**

Capital City Cleanup litter kits are available for free and can be requested by filling out [this form](#) on the City's website. The City also offers funding under the [Community Bin Grant Program](#) on a first-come, first-served basis for bin rentals (including the truck, driver and disposal costs) and truck rentals that can collect large items in your neighbourhood.
